### **Job Description**

A Rail Signaling Assembler works in the rail industry and is responsible for the regular servicing of a track's electrical equipment, such as switches, wires, and Lights.

They must have a solid understanding of circuitry, electronic rail devices, communication systems, and general machinery used on railroads. Signal Maintainers might service freight or passenger tracks, or they may perform repairs railway systems.

Main Duties:

You service the electrical equipment on and alongside the tracks of railroads and subways.

You may install and test wires, mechanical components and track switches.

When parts on the track malfunction, you are called in to inspect and repair them.

For example, a Rail Signaling Assembler may replace faulty wiring, repair lights and lubricate gate crossings.

To perform your job, you must be knowledgeable about railroad machinery, electronics, transportation and public safety.

You may work outdoors on freight and passenger train tracks, as well as underground on subways lines.

You may be required to work irregular hours. The work can be dangerous, due to environmental conditions, transportation safety and high voltage

Equipment.: You have to unwind all kind of cables (Copper, fiber optic, coaxial, power, etc. . .)
