Duties:

We are looking for a technician to join our Automation, Operations and Fluids Group for work within the ILL's Endurance programme. Your main duties will include:

- the performance of studies and analyses for special-purpose-machine-type projects
- the design of the electrical diagrams (IGE+XAO applications)
- the writing of specifications for the production of electrical boxes and cabinets
- consulting, selecting and supervising the suppliers
- acceptance and testing of the electrical enclosures
- programming the control systems (Siemens and/or Schneider software) and HMI systems
- supervision of the ILL cabling operations
- testing and commissioning
- writing the documentation required (instructions, minutes, production records).

Qualifications and experience

- At least two years of post-A level studies in electrical engineering, automation/process control, or equivalent
- Experience in programming automatic control systems and industrial computing.
- Some familiarity with quality assurance and machine safety.
