Goals

- 1 Reduce youth unemployment rate to 23.5%**
- 2 Increase activity rate to 73.5%**
- 3 Reduce the current gender gap by 20%**
- 4 15% more permanent contracts each year**
- 5 Train at least:**
 - **43% (100,000)** unemployed registered young people with no Compulsory Secondary Education qualification in key skills in Spanish and Mathematics.
 - **30%** of young people in **language skills**.
 - **225,000** young people in **digital skills (75% in basic skills, 25% in advanced)**.
 - **25% (40,000)** of young people in **strategic sectors skills**.
